

New Jersey Pay It Forward



Get a 0% interest loan to train for a new career; only pay it back when you land a better job. Also receive a living stipend you won't have to repay.

— ABOUT THE PROGRAM

Starting a new career can be challenging. You might be wondering, how can I afford the cost of training or take time off from my current job to pursue my dreams? A new state-backed initiative can help you overcome these challenges.

The New Jersey Pay It Forward Program is designed to prepare NJ residents for in-demand, well-paying jobs in industries like health care, IT, and clean energy.

Through the NJ Pay It Forward Program, you can complete your training now and pay back tuition costs only after you land a well-paying job.

— HOW DOES IT WORK?

1

Enroll in one of our training programs. **Thanks to a 0% interest, zero-fee loan, you pay nothing upfront.**

2

Receive a living stipend and supportive services to help you graduate and succeed

3

Land a well-paying job in the field you trained for.

4

If you earn more than a minimum salary, you pay back your loan through monthly payments that vary based upon your discretionary income, for up to five years. You never pay back more than the starting balance of your loan.

5

Your loan repayments go back into the NJ Pay It Forward Program, "paying it forward" so more New Jerseyans can access high-quality training.

— ELIGIBLE SCHOOLS & PROGRAMS

New Jersey Institute of Technology

The Cybersecurity Professional Bootcamp at NJIT is a 10-month, part-time course delivered online. Students learn topics including computer networking, cloud and network security, and Python.

Hudson County Community College

The Nursing program is a two-year, full-time Associate degree program at HCCC's Jersey City campus and nearby hospitals. Students prepare for roles as Registered Nurses and complete clinical placements.

The Radiography program at Hudson County Community College is a two-year, full-time Associate degree program at HCCC's Jersey City campus and nearby imaging centers. Students prepare for roles as radiologic technologists and complete clinical placements.

Camden County College

The Heating, Ventilation & Air Conditioning (HVAC) or Welding courses at Camden County College are nine-month, part-time courses that take place in-person.

The LPN to RN Program is a two year, full-time Associate degree program at Camden County College. Students prepare for roles as Registered Nurses and complete clinical placements.

The Practical Nursing Program is a three-semester, certificate program at Camden County College that prepares graduates for a career in practical nursing.

Rowan College at Burlington County

The Nursing program at Rowan College at Burlington County is a two-year, full-time Associate degree program at RCBC's Mount Laurel campus and nearby hospitals. Students prepare for roles as Registered Nurses and complete clinical placements

The Radiography Program is a two-year, full-time Associate degree program at the Mount Laurel campus and nearby imaging centers. Students prepare for roles as Registered Radiologic Technologists..

Brookdale Community College

The Nursing program at Brookdale Community College is a two-year, full-time Associate degree program at Brookdale's Lincroft main campus and nearby hospitals. Students prepare for roles as Registered Nurses and complete clinical placements.

The Radiologic Technology Program is a two-year, full-time Associate degree program at Brookdale's Lincroft main campus and nearby imaging centers. Students prepare for roles as Radiologic Technicians and complete clinical placements.

EXAMPLE LOAN REPAYMENT SCENARIOS



Student A

Student A borrows \$10,000 to attend training. They complete the program but **find a job that pays \$35,000 per year.**

Student A has a household size of two, so their minimum income threshold for repayment is \$42,660.

Student A's monthly loan payments are \$0 until their earnings increase above the minimum income threshold. If they don't increase during the five-year loan term, Student A's **loan balance is forgiven in full.**



Student B

Student B borrows \$10,000 to attend training. They complete the program and **find a job that pays \$52,000 per year.**

Student B has a household size of three, so their minimum income threshold for repayment is \$50,730.

Student B will repay \$111 per month towards their loan. After five years, they have repaid \$6,660 toward their loan and the **remaining balance is forgiven.**



Student C

Student C borrows \$10,000 to attend training. They complete the program and **find a job that pays \$55,000 per year.**

Student C has a household size of two, so their minimum income threshold for repayment is \$42,660.

Student C will repay \$203 per month towards their loan. After just under 4.5 years, the full \$10,000 loan and their obligation is fulfilled.

What Makes This Program Different?

The NJ Pay It Forward Program is financed through a partnership between the State of New Jersey and the NJ CEO Council and managed by Social Finance, a national nonprofit. This loan program is designed to be even more student-friendly than federal student loans. We believe you have the right to finance your education in a way that's linked to your career success. That's why you can count on us for:



0% interest, zero-fee loans with significant downside protections.

- You only pay back your loan if you earn above a minimum salary in a given month.
- You never pay back more than the original amount you borrowed.
- You don't have to make any payments while you are training or during the three-month grace period, and you do not have to repay any portion of your living stipend.

Credit history not required—you are still eligible for the loan even if you have no or poor credit.
